#### **General Functions:**

Under the overall guidance of the Chief of Mission and the Head of Aceh/ Nias Program for administration matters, and under direct supervision of the Health Project Manager for medical/technical matters, the incumbent will assist in the implementation of the Community Health Revitalization Program (CHRP) Project "Improving Child, Maternal and Community Health in Western District of Aceh Province, Special Focus on TLC's", and will have the follow duties and responsibilities:

1. Actively participates in the delivery and timely implementation, monitoring and evaluation of all CHRP-related activities.
2. Assist in the organization and implementation of capacity building of health staff in the Puskesmas and District Health Office.
3. Assist in the planning, procurement and distribution of training materials.
4. Liaise/collaborate with the international health agencies present in Meulaboh and Banda Aceh as well as district, provincial and national health authorities to ensure IOM's plan of action complements the actions of others and fits well within the national and Aceh Strategic Health Plan 2006-2010 (RENSTRA). In this respect, attending coordination and inter-agency meetings.
5. Assist in the implementation of the Childbirth Emergency and Post Partum Package Program in the Puskesmas and conduct monitoring thereafter.
6. Contribute to regular reporting on achievements, projects, problems encountered, pertinent developments and strategic needs, including narrative and financial reports for donors, government partners, and/or as requested by IOM section/department heads.
7. Provide support to medical doctors and other support teams.
8. Participates in-house coordination among the different sections/programs in the sub-office
9. Assists with translations and/or acts as interpreter/translator as needed.
10. Undertake other duties that may be assigned from time to time which are commensurate to the position.

Desirable qualifications:

Education and experience: University degree in Nursing, Health and/or Social and/or other related sciences with experience in community and public health particularly in post – emergency rehabilitation. Knowledge of structures and functions of national and international health agencies, donors and organizations.

Excellent communication and negotiation skills; experiences in liaising with governmental as well as national and international institutions preferred. Ability to prepare clear and concise reports; Capacity for independent work; strong strategic and creative thinking; Commitment, drive for results, and effective resource management skills are all required.
